How to support and engage with your child?

Be autonomy supportive

- → Listen without judgment and acknowledge your child's perspective and feelings. This shows that their viewpoints are valued and their experiences matter to you.
- → Clarify the importance of school assignments by illustrating how they can benefit daily life or contribute to achieving their goals.

Structure their environment

- → Clearly communicate rules and expectations, and set consistent and predictable consequences. Define what is required during homework time, including the expected duration and specific goals.
- → Offer constructive feedback by highlighting both strengths and areas for improvement, focusing on effort and progress.
- → Provide the necessary resources and support to ensure your child has the tools needed for their assignments, and provide help when needed.
