Environmental factors

the parent

- has good collaboration and effective communication with teachers
- perceives the school climate as positive
- feels that the school environment is welcoming to parents
- can be involved in their child's school life



Child-related factors

the child

- succeeds well in school
- does not encounter significant academic, behavioral, or emotional difficulties



Parent-related factors

the parent has

- a good self-esteem
- a high level of vitality
- intrinsic values (e.g., aspires to contribute to the community)
- a high level of education
